

Reporting guidance for issues that may be experienced by the communities of Epping Forest

Report to Essex Police

Always dial **999** when: a serious crime is believed in progress or has recently occurred; someone is in immediate danger or harm; property is in danger of being damaged or a serious disruption to the public is likely. There are many ways to report a variety of non-urgent matters online at www.essex.police.uk, as an alternative to calling **101**. This includes a Live Chat service operated daily between 7am-11pm, with reports dealt with in the same way as when calling 101.

Report to Crimestoppers/Fearless

Crimestoppers is a charity independent from the police, who will take information 100% anonymously, before passing it to the best law enforcement organisation. Information can be taken via www.crimestoppers-uk.org or freephone **0800 555 111**. There is some information Crimestoppers cannot process, such as if the informant is reporting an emergency or is a victim of crime, which will require the police. Fearless is the youth branch of Crimestoppers and works in the same way for young people, with online reporting via www.fearless.org
